

LEAs may provide a list of their Title IV Part A programs and trainings to private schools and encourage participation.

LEAs may ask how they can best serve private schools (should be based on the private schools' needs assessment) and consider reasonable requests from their private schools.



Whether to consolidate and use Title I Part A funds in coordination with funds from other eligible programs that are dedicated to providing equitable services to private school students.

All efforts should be made to resolve conflicts at the local level. Both LEAs and private schools may reach out to the Title IV, Part A office with questions and concerns. If a conflict persists, the Florida Equitable Services Ombudsman, Nicolle Tanner, should be contacted at Nicolle.Tanner@fldoe.org.

Continued efforts should be made to contact and partnership with private schools within the LEA service area. LEAs should continue contact attempts and maintain documentation of those attempts.
